

## Foreign Minister

*"National leader John Key has said if his party wins power in this year's election he may also appoint Winston Peters as Foreign Minister. Based on Winston Peters overall performance as Foreign Minister do you think he should remain in the post if National and NZ First were to form the next government?"*

- New Zealanders are fairly evenly split when asked whether Winston Peters should remain in his position as Foreign Minister if National and NZ First were to form the next Government
  - 41% believe he should remain while slightly more 47% believe he shouldn't
- Low household income earners – earn less than \$30,000 per year (57%) are more likely to say he should remain in the post than high household income earners – earn over \$70,000 per year (37%)
- Labour Party supporters (44%) are more inclined to believe he should keep his position than National Party Supporters (36%)
