"Is there anyone who is not a current M.P. who you would prefer to be Prime Minister?"

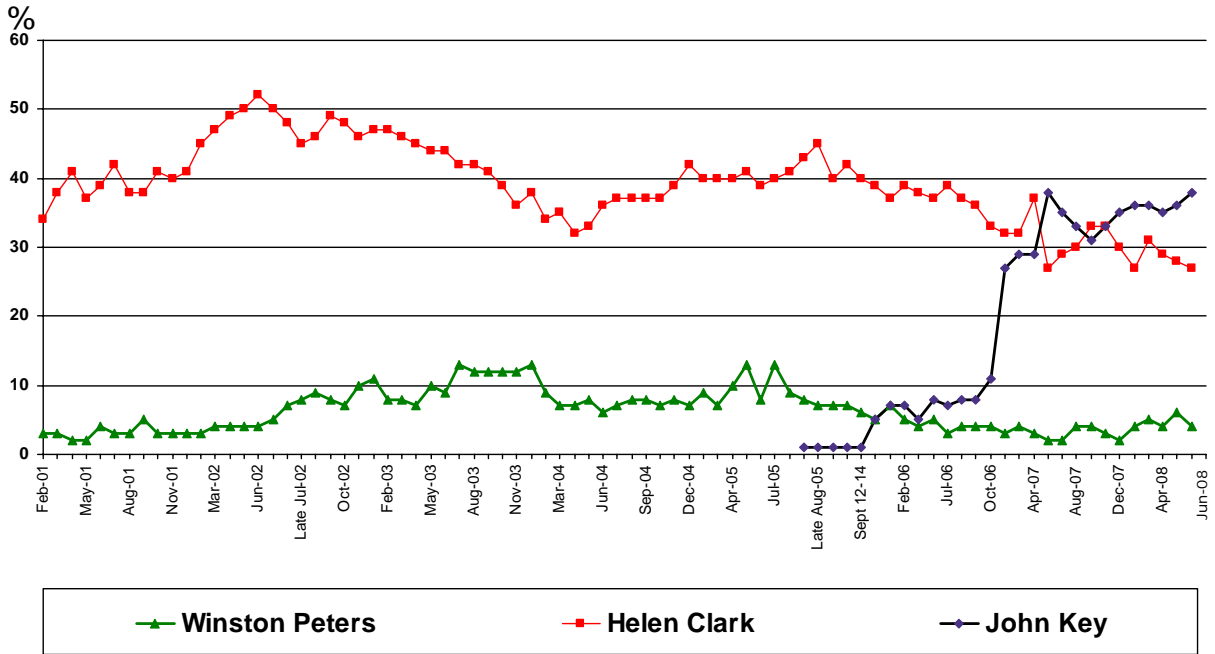
